

PhD Offer - Clinical Research in Addiction and Associated Comorbidities

The clinical research laboratory of Dr. Didier Jutras-Aswad at CRCHUM offers a PhD internship opportunity in the field of drug addiction and psychiatric comorbidities.

Presentation:

Under the authority of the principal investigator, the Ph.D. student will join the clinical research team and work on one of the laboratory's active research projects. He will have the opportunity to acquire expertise and master the various activities involved in clinical and / or epidemiological studies: initiation of study, adherence to the highest standards for data collection, knowledge of the different regulatory aspects of projects, development analysis strategies, analysis of data, writing of articles for publication in scientific journals and participation in scientific outreach activities (congresses, conferences, etc.).

Requirements:

- Candidates must have a master's degree in a relevant discipline (ex. psychiatric sciences, biomedical and clinical sciences, epidemiology, neuroscience, psychology). In the case where the Master's thesis has not yet been filed at the time of the application, provide a certificate of the deposit of the thesis;
- Candidates must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents in Quebec at the time of entry into force of the scholarship, or be in possession of a visa allowing them to study there;
- Be motivated and have a strong interest in working with populations suffering from addictions and mental health;
- Make a commitment to apply for a PhD scholarship during the course of their studies;
- Good knowledge of French and English;
- Analytical mind, autonomy, strong writing ability, ability to work in a team

Conditions:

- Status: full time
- Location: CRCHUM
- Duration of the fellowship: duration of the PhD

Documents to present:

- A motivation letter indicating the candidate's academic career and future career goals;
- A resume;
- The transcripts of the 2nd cycle;
- Two (2) references

Evaluation of applications:

The internship will be granted according to the merit of the submitted file. All of the applications will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Academic excellence (notes, awards, distinctions, publications);
- Demonstrated interest and demonstrated ability to pursue PhD studies in the field of addiction and comorbidities.

- All applicants will receive an acknowledgment of receipt, but only those who have met the selection criteria will be invited for an interview;
- Applications that do not comply with the terms and conditions of this offer notice will not be considered;
