

SUBJECT: Postdoctoral fellowship - Clinical Research in Addiction and Associated Comorbidities

The clinical research laboratory directed by Dr. Didier Jutras-Aswad at CrCHUM is offering a postdoctoral fellowship in the field of drug addiction and psychiatric comorbidities.

Description :

The postdoctoral fellow will have the opportunity to be involved in clinical trials evaluating drug treatment and psychiatric co-morbidities.

The postdoctoral fellow will be part of a research team established for the accomplishment of these research projects. Under the supervision of the principal investigator, the postdoctoral fellow will have the opportunity to acquire expertise and master various activities within clinical trials, such as: study initiation, adherence to the highest standards for data collection, knowledge of different regulatory aspects of projects, development of analytical strategies, data analysis, writing articles for publication in scientific journals, participation in scientific outreach activities (scientific congress, symposium, etc.) and preparation of funding applications.

Required Skills:

- Postgraduate degree in Biomedical Sciences, Psychiatry, Neuroscience, Psychology, or other relevant discipline,
- Be motivated and have experience in clinical research in the field of psychiatry, addiction or related fields,
- Strong interest in working with populations suffering from addictions and mental health,
- Strong quantitative analysis skills,
- Good knowledge of French and English,
- Autonomous ability to synthesize, good writing skills, ability to work in a team.

Conditions of the internship:

- Status: full time.
- Location of the internship: CHUM Research Center.
- Duration : two years.
